## ORPC Poised for Growth and New Opportunities Company Leadership Expanding

**Portland, Maine, February 7, 2017** - Ocean Renewable Power Company (ORPC), a global leader in hydrokinetic power systems and project solutions, announced today that it is instituting a new management approach to advance company growth and capitalize on new opportunities.
